- To showcase Canadian authors
- To promote the joy of reading among children and adults

The Membership Manager will administer the admission, record-keeping and termination of memberships, and will communicate with members as necessary. Prospective members will apply by filling out an application form (name, phone, email address) and submitting it to the Membership Manager for processing. Membership will be for a one year term. Annual renewal of members by email will be the responsibility of the Membership Manager. Membership will end at the written request of the member, at the discretion of the Board, or as stipulated in Section 3 of By-law #1.

There is no fee to be a member.

Members in good standing have access to all benefits and privileges of Lakefield Literary Festival membership including:

- An invitation to attend and the right to vote at the Annual General Meeting
- The right to receive financial statements in the event there is no AGM
- The right to stand for and hold positions on the Board of Directors
- The right to elect members of the Board of Directors
